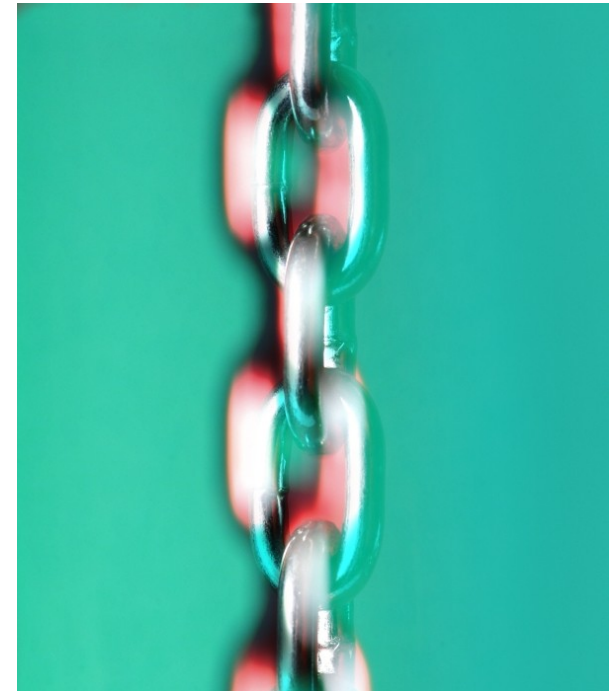

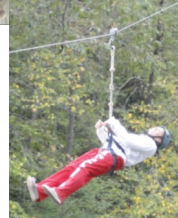
PACKING
